About the Artist

Edward Poston is a native of Clearfield, Utah. He holds a Bachelor’s degree in Organ Performance from Brigham Young University-Idaho, and a Master’s degree in Church Music and Organ from the University of Kansas.

Edward began piano studies at age four, and began playing the organ at age eight. In high school, he played the violin and cello, and conducted his high school where he gained a love for orchestral conducting. During the past fourteen years, Edward has served Protestant and Catholic denominations as organist and music director in Utah, Idaho, Kansas, and Missouri. He recently served as the first Associate Director of the Bales Chorale Society at the University of Kansas from 2024-2025.

Additionally, Mr. Poston has accompanied various collegiate choirs, vocal soloists, instrumentalists, ballet classes, and rehearsals for Broadway musicals. He is a doctoral student at the University of Kansas studying Church Music and Organ and is currently doing dissertation work on LDS hymnody in the 21st century. A budding hymnologist, Edward will present a section featuring the new 2027 LDS hymnal, “Hymns for Home and Church” at the 2026 Hymn Society Conference in Princeton, New Jersey. Edward began as Associate Organist and Communications Coordinator in this Cathedral in August 2025.
